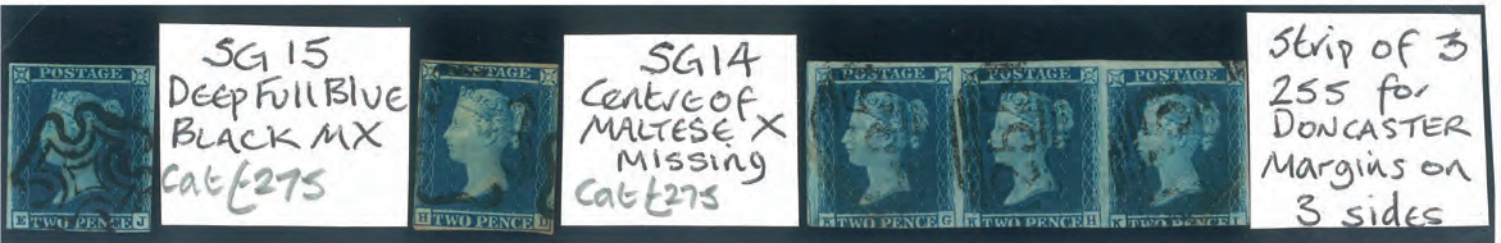

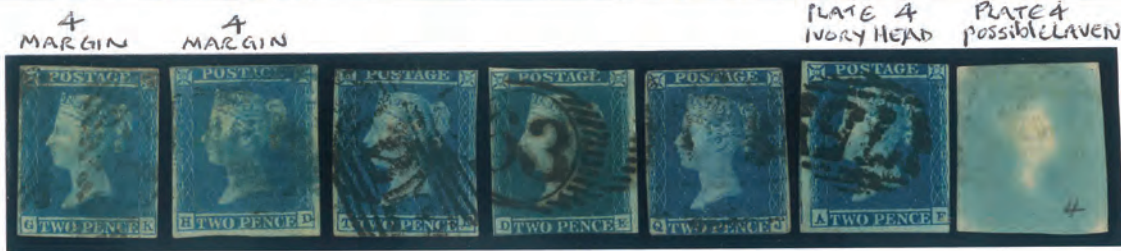

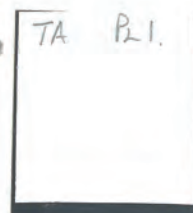

RE-ENTRIES

PLATE 27. The only re-entry on this plate is due to the letters A and D being punched much too low and extending across the margin into the top of the stamp below. The letters were then erased and entered in their correct position but strong evidence of the original entry remains in the margin between the two stamps and the upper corners of the lower stamp.



PLATE 41. Most stamps on the top four rows have the top right hand square and right hand side re-entered. Four typical examples :-



PLATE 46. Stamp B.H. shows a strong re-entry in the upper portion and also traces of the re-entry along the base of the stamp.



PLATE 55. Re-entry marks in the upper and lower portions on all stamps occur in the first three vertical rows and in stamps H.D, R.D, & T.D. of the fourth row. Whilst the intensity of these re-entries varies from the slightest trace to a very strong re-entry their similarity on each stamp suggests that they were conveyed by the roller when the plate was laid down. As further evidence of this the corner letters themselves which were punched in afterwards do not show any trace of re-entry. Six stamps from the first three rows showing the re-entry increasing in intensity from left to right on the page.

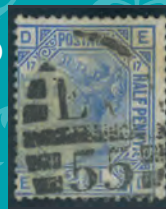
